Germany is back, says Merz, after sealing government deal

Future expectations for Germany after this agreement indicate political and economic stability, with the potential to strengthen and revive the German economy after the economic crisis it has faced. The new government is expected to focus on restoring economic competitiveness, boosting investments in key sectors, and fulfilling defense commitments. There is also a possibility of improving relations with the European Union and the United States, particularly in terms of trade and economy. This agreement could contribute to strengthening Germany's role in European leadership and achieving sustainable economic growth despite global challenges.

El Salvador says it shares gang intel with specific deportees

El Salvador's Minister of Security and Justice, Gustavo Villatoro, told CNN in an exclusive interview that the country shares intelligence with the United States about wanted gang members and provides "complete records" on them before officially requesting their deportation. "We raise our hands and say, 'Look, this guy," Villatoro said, emphasizing that the process "is not random." His remarks the US — and requests follow the Trump administration's deportation of over 270 men to El Salvador, accused of being members of the Venezuelan Tren de Aragua gang or linked to the MS-13 gang. Deportations and intelligence coordination between El Salvador and the U.S. are expected to increase, strengthening efforts to crack down on gang violence and reduce criminal activity in the region.

Trump's unconventional NASA pick signals Mars intentions in confirmation hearing

Jared Isaacman, billionaire CEO of Shift4 and twice a SpaceX passenger, faced a Senate confirmation hearing as Trump's nominee to lead NASA. He signaled a new focus on Mars exploration, raising questions about shifting NASA's priorities from the Moon to Mars. This potential change could impact the Artemis program, which aims to establish a human presence on the Moon. The Senate will vote on Isaacman's confirmation after returning from recess on April 28. The Mars push aligns with Elon Musk's long-held vision and comes amid his growing influence with Trump, including a \$260 million investment in Trump's campaign.
