### Syrian letter delivers response to US conditions for sanctions relief

Syria sent a formal letter responding to a list of conditions set by the United States for potential easing of sanctions. In the letter, Syria claimed it had addressed most U.S. demands, such as efforts to eliminate remaining chemical weapons and help locate missing Americans like journalist Austin Tice. However, Syria noted that some issues, including the role of foreign fighters in government and permissions for U.S. counterterrorism operations, would need further dialogue. The letter also emphasized Syria's commitment not to threaten U.S., Western, or Israeli interests, and highlighted steps to monitor Palestinian factions operating within its borders.



### Iran, US resume talks in Oman to narrow gaps over new nuclear deal

The United States and Iran resumed indirect nuclear talks in Muscat, Oman, on April 26, 2025, aiming to bridge differences over a potential new nuclear agreement. Mediated by Omani officials, discussions involved senior diplomats from both sides. While some progress had been made in previous rounds, major sticking points remain, particularly Iran's insistence on maintaining its uranium enrichment program and missile capabilities, which the U.S. wants to restrict. Iran is seeking sanctions relief amid mounting economic pressure and military tensions. Talks began at the expert level with the goal of drafting a framework that could eventually lead to a broader agreement.



### Trump and Ukraine's Zelenskiy have 'very productive' meeting in Rome, says US official

On April 26, 2025, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskiy met privately with U.S. President Donald Trump in Rome while both were attending Pope Francis' funeral. It was their first meeting since tensions surfaced during a February visit to Washington. The discussion focused on efforts to negotiate peace between Ukraine and Russia, though major differences remain. The U.S. has proposed controversial ideas such as recognizing Crimea as Russian territory and adjusting sanctions, which Ukraine and European allies oppose. Zelenskiy, dressed in military-style clothing to show solidarity with Ukrainian soldiers, emphasized Ukraine's position.
