Trump took the US economy to the brink of a crisis in just 100 days

Yemen's Houthi rebels allege US airstrike hit a prison holding **African migrants** Yemen's Houthi rebels alleged on Monday that a US airstrike hit a prison holding African migrants in Saada governorate, killing and wounding some of the 100 inmates. The US military had no immediate comment. The strike adds to Yemen's decade-long conflict, where African migrants risk their lives trying to reach Saudi Arabia. It also raises new questions about the US campaign, "Operation Rough Rider," amid negotiations with Iran. Graphic footage showed dead and wounded at the site. The US Central Command defended its policy of withholding operational details but did not comment on the alleged strike when contacted.

North Korea confirms it sent troops to fight for Russia in Ukraine war

North Korea has confirmed for the first time that it sent troops to fight for Russia against Ukraine, according to state news agency KCNA. Pyongyang claimed its soldiers helped liberate the Kursk region, following an order by Kim Jong Un. Russia's military chief praised the "heroism" of North Korean troops, while Western officials estimate that around 1,000 of the 11,000 North Korean soldiers have been killed. The U.S. criticized North Korea for fueling the war. Despite reports that North Korean troops are poorly trained, Ukrainian commanders warned they pose a serious challenge due to their numbers and Soviet-style tactics.
