Powerful quake in Southeast Asia kills dozens, Myanmar bears brunt

A 7.7-magnitude earthquake struck Myanmar on March 28, causing widespread destruction and killing at least 144 people, according to state media. The quake, with an epicenter near Mandalay, also injured 732 people and toppled buildings, bridges, and roads. In Thailand, a partially built tower collapsed in Bangkok, leaving 117 people missing and killing five. Rescuers are searching for survivors, with reports of people trapped under debris. The ongoing conflict between Myanmar's military junta and insurgents may further complicate relief efforts.



Israel conducts first strike on Beirut's southern suburbs since truce

Israel launched an airstrike on Beirut's southern suburbs on March 28, targeting a Hezbollah drone storage facility after rockets were fired from Lebanon. The attack tested a fragile ceasefire reached in November, which has been increasingly unstable. Israel and Hezbollah accuse each other of violations, with Israeli artillery also striking southern Lebanon. Lebanese officials and French President Macron criticized the airstrike, calling it unjustified. Meanwhile, fighting continues in Gaza, raising concerns of a broader conflict. The UN warned against escalation, fearing renewed violence similar to last year's devastating war, which displaced 1.3 million Lebanese civilians



Viral Studio Ghibli-style Al images showcase power - and copyright concerns - of ChatGPT update

OpenAI's latest AI image generator, released with GPT-4o, has sparked a viral trend mimicking Studio Ghibli's art style, raising both admiration and copyright concerns. Users flooded social media with Al-generated Ghiblistyle scenes from pop culture, politics, and memes. However, Studio Ghibli co-founder Hayao Miyazaki has previously condemned Al-generated art as an "insult to life itself." The trend reignited debates over Al's impact on art, especially amid concerns over copyrighted works being used for training. OpenAI CEO Sam Altman jokingly acknowledged the viral interest, while ChatGPT refused to generate Ghibli-style images due to content policies.
