Zelensky confirms for first time that Ukrainian troops active in Russia's Belgorod region

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky confirmed for the first time on Monday evening that Ukrainian forces are active in Russia's Belgorod region, as part of efforts to protect Ukrainian towns near the border. Zelensky noted that Ukrainian troops remain stationed in parts of the neighboring Russian region of Kursk, eight months after a cross-border incursion. He added that although Russian forces have regained much of the previously lost territory, Ukraine's main objective remains the protection of its land and communities in the Sumy and Kharkiv regions from Russian forces. At the end of his speech, Zelensky highlighted the military operations being carried out by units of Ukraine's 225th Assault Regiment in those areas and praised the unit for its outstanding performance in combat operations.

US in direct nuclear talks with Iran, Trump says

Donald Trump announced that the United States and Iran will hold "talks on Saturday regarding a potential nuclear deal." Iran's foreign minister confirmed the meeting, but noted that the talks would be "indirect" and could serve as both an opportunity and a test. Trump stated that the discussions between Washington and Tehran would be at a "very high level," warning that it would be a "very bad day for Iran" if no agreement is reached. The announcement of these talks came after a meeting at the White House with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, who had previously suggested the possibility of attacking Iran to prevent it from acquiring nuclear weapons.

Pakistani Star's Bollywood Return Excites Fans and Sparks Controversy

Excitement is growing in India with the return of Pakistani star Fawad Khan to Bollywood after a long absence due to an industry ban on artists from neighboring countries. Khan, a popular actor, singer, and producer, announced his comeback last week, 18 months after an Indian court ruled the 2016 ban on Pakistani talent illegal. He posted on Instagram, "The wait is over! Bringing love back to the big screen," alongside a teaser for his upcoming rom-com Abir Gulaal, set to release on May 9. Fans have expressed their excitement, both online and in Mumbai, with many hopeful for the film's success. As expectations rise, it is anticipated that Khan's return will help strengthen the cultural connection between India and Pakistan.
