An Israeli air strike in Khan Younis, Gaza, killed Hamas political leader Salah al-Bardaweel and his wife. Bardaweel, one of Hamas's highest-ranking figures, was targeted while praying. This attack follows the collapse of a nearly two-month ceasefire, with Israel blaming Hamas for rejecting a new truce proposal. Hamas accused Israel of abandoning the original deal, which aimed to withdraw troops and release hostages. The air strike is part of a broader escalation in Gaza, with heavy bombardments continuing and at least 18 people reported dead, worsening the ongoing conflict and humanitarian crisis.

Pope Francis to be discharged from hospital, with prescription for two months of rest

Pope Francis, 88, who has been battling pneumonia for over five weeks, will be discharged from Rome's Gemelli hospital on Sunday. However, his doctors have prescribed two months of rest at the Vatican for full recovery, advising against meetings or strenuous activities. Francis, who fought severe respiratory crises, is no longer battling pneumonia but remains affected by a complex infection. He will make his first public appearance in over five weeks on Sunday to offer a blessing from his hospital room. The Vatican will reassess upcoming events, including the Pope's planned meetings and Easter celebrations.
