👉 Venice divided as lavish Bezos wedding brings glamour and protests

Jeff Bezos's lavish wedding in Venice sparked protests over over-tourism and climate concerns, though disruptions remained minimal. Locals are divided: some welcome wealthy visitors for economic gains, others fear Venice is turning into a playground for billionaires, worsening housing crises. The IAEA's chief Rafael Grossi warns Iran could resume uranium enrichment for a nuclear bomb within months, despite US-Israeli strikes on Iranian nuclear sites. He contradicts Trump's claims of total destruction, noting Iran retains key nuclear capacities. Tensions deepen as Iran's parliament moves to suspend cooperation with the IAEA. While Tehran insists its program is peaceful, fears grow over its nuclear ambitions and a fragile ceasefire with Israel.

A crucial geopolitical risk; nuclear proliferation fears remain high.

👉 Riot police clash with protesters calling for end to Serbian president's rule

Mass protests erupted in Belgrade demanding President Vucic's resignation and early elections, fueled by anger over corruption and authoritarianism. Clashes between riot police and protesters resulted in injuries and arrests. Despite smaller protests lately, Saturday's large turnout shows continued resistance. Vucic denies snap elections, blaming foreign plots.

Significant domestic unrest signals political instability and potential democratic backsliding in Serbia.
