

The hackers' return after recent U.S.-Iran clashes suggests cyber operations may serve as a lower-risk tool of retaliation, keeping geopolitical tensions simmering without sparking direct conflict.

Thai Prime Minister Paetongtarn's fate in limbo Paetongtarn Shinawatra's suspension highlights Thailand's ongoing power struggle between elected leaders tied to the Shinawatra family and conservative institutions like the military and judiciary. Her controversial call with Hun Sen has weakened her coalition and public support, raising doubts about her political future. If the court removes her, Thailand could face renewed political instability and possible shifts in leadership or elections.
