President Donald Trump filed a \$10 billion defamation lawsuit in Miami federal court against The Wall Street Journal, Dow Jones, News Corp, Rupert Murdoch, CEO Robert Thomson and two reporters. He claims a WSJ article falsely alleged he sent Jeffrey Epstein a suggestive birthday greeting-complete with drawing and hidden reference-damaged his finances and reputation. Trump denies the claim and the DOJ is also pushing to unseal Epstein-related grand jury transcripts.

India's financial crime fighting agency summons Google, Meta executives, sources say

India's Enforcement Directorate (ED) summoned executives from Google and Meta to its New Delhi headquarters as part of an ongoing money-laundering investigation tied to online betting apps. The ED is probing whether the tech firms facilitated promotion of these apps through advertisements and received payments from betting platforms, potentially violating a 2022 government advisory discouraging betting-related promotions. Google and Meta have not yet responded to media inquiries


Israel and Syria agree ceasefire as Israel allows Syrian troops limited access to Sweida

Israel and Syria reached a ceasefire agreement after deadly clashes in southern Syria's Druze-majority Sweida province, which left over 300 people killed. Israel agreed to allow limited deployment of Syrian internal security forces into the area for 48 hours to help stabilize the situation. The ceasefire, brokered by the U.S. ambassador to Turkey and supported by Turkey, Jordan, and other regional players, follows recent Israeli airstrikes protecting the Druze community
