As the administration continues its campaign, it may create market uncertainty and destabilize financial conditions, complicating the Fed's ability to maintain credibility and effective policy.

Israel will strike Iran threatened, again defence minister says

Israeli Defence Minister Israel Katz's statement emphasizes Israel's readiness to strike Iran again if threatened, reflecting the fragile nature of the ceasefire established after a 12-day air war in June. Israel's strikes on Iranian nuclear sites, backed by U.S. support, raised fears of a wider regional conflict. Moving forward, the situation remains tense, with the possibility of escalating hostilities leading to a broader conflict, affecting regional stability and global diplomacy.
