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Iran and Europeans begin nuclear talks with questions over future UN sanctions

Iran has resumed nuclear talks with European powers in Istanbul amid rising tensions after recent U.S. and Israeli strikes. With the October 18 deadline to extend U.N. sanctions nearing, Europe seeks concrete steps from Iran—such as IAEA cooperation and accounting for missing enriched uranium—to delay the deadline. However, Iran firmly rejects extending Resolution 2231, making a diplomatic breakthrough unlikely. If no progress is made, snapback sanctions may be triggered, worsening regional instability.

UK backs future
Palestinian statehood
but says ceasefire the
top priority

The UK's support for a future Palestinian state, combined with its urgent call for a ceasefire in Gaza, underscores the tension between long-term political goals and immediate humanitarian needs. With mass starvation worsening in Gaza, Britain prioritizes ending the suffering before advancing statehood discussions. This approach aligns with other international leaders but faces strong opposition from Israel and the U.S. A ceasefire could reopen diplomatic paths, but failure risks deepening the crisis and regional instability.

Thailand, Cambodia
exchange heavy
artillery as fighting
expands for second day

The renewed artillery clashes between Thailand and Cambodia represent their worst border conflict in over a decade, driven by long-standing disputes and recent provocations. Despite international calls for a ceasefire, fighting has intensified, causing civilian casualties and displacement. Thailand's military advantage and refusal of third-party mediation complicate prospects for a quick resolution. Without deescalation, the conflict risks worsening the humanitarian crisis and regional instability.
