Thailand and Cambodia thank Trump for mediation, but shelling continues

During a private visit to Scotland, U.S. President Donald Trump urged Cambodia and Thailand to agree to an immediate ceasefire following recent border clashes. Posting on Truth Social, Trump claimed both nations agreed to meet quickly and pursue peace. Cambodia confirmed its acceptance of a ceasefire, while Thailand emphasized the need for dialogue first. Despite his intervention, shelling continued overnight. At least 33 people have died and thousands have been displaced. Trump linked future trade talks to an end to the fighting, ahead of new U.S. tariffs on both countries set to begin on August 1. Mediation offers had been previously rejected.

Greece battles wildfires, evacuating residents near Athens

Greece is battling five major wildfires amid a severe heatwave, with temperatures reaching 44°C. Fires have forced evacuations just 30km north of Athens, and the smoke has reached the capital. In Kythira, scenes of "total destruction" led to the evacuation of 139 people by sea. In Messinia and Crete, fires continue to spread, fueled by strong winds. Over 80 firefighters, 30 vehicles, and aircraft are battling the blazes. Officials warn of continued fire threats in multiple regions, including the Ionian Islands, Peloponnese, and Central Greece. Greece has requested EU assistance as homes burn and forest areas are destroyed.

A man in India ran a fake embassy, Indian police say

Indian police arrested Harshvardhan Jain, 47, for running a fake embassy from a rented home near New Delhi. Posing as an ambassador for fictitious entities like "Seborga" and "Westarctica," he allegedly duped people by promising overseas jobs. Authorities found doctored photos with world leaders, forged seals from India's foreign ministry and 30+ countries, four cars with fake diplomatic plates, and over 4.5 million rupees (\$52,095) in cash. Jain is also suspected of laundering money via shell companies abroad. He faces charges of forgery, impersonation, and possessing fake documents.
