Oil prices fall as Ukraine talks raise prospect of sanctions easing

Oil prices edged lower on August 19, 2025, with Brent crude hovering around \$66.5 per barrel and WTI near \$63.4, as markets responded to U.S.-led diplomatic efforts -via Trump-to convene a trilateral summit between Russia, Ukraine, and the U.S. Analysts suggest that if Russian oil sanctions were to be eased, prices could drop further, potentially averaging \$58 per barrel in late 2025 to early 2026. However, lingering concerns about a deal skewed toward Russia and geopolitical uncertainties temper expectations, making outlooks cautious.

Thailand to launch crypto-to-baht conversion for foreign tourists

Thailand has introduced an 18-month pilot scheme allowing foreign tourists to convert cryptocurrencies into Thai baht for local spending, capped at 550,000 baht (about \$16,950), aiming to revitalize its struggling tourism sector. The initiative enables tourists to use Thai-based crypto exchanges for conversion, with funds transferred to online wallets for spending at local businesses. Authorities may reassess the cap after the trial period. The scheme is expected to boost early tourist spending, though tourist arrivals are still forecasted down by 10% from pre-pandemic levels, reaching 33 million in 2025 compared to 39.9 million in 2019.

UK backs down in Apple privacy row, US says

The UK has withdrawn its demand that Apple create a "back door" to access encrypted user data worldwide, following strong pushback from the U.S. and privacy advocates. The order, issued under the Investigatory Powers Act, would have undermined Apple's Advanced Data Protection system, which even the company itself cannot bypass. While the reversal is hailed as a victory for digital privacy, civil liberties groups warn that the UK's legal powers to weaken encryption remain in place, posing future risks. The episode highlights the ongoing tension between national security imperatives and safeguarding citizens' civil liberties in the digital age.
