WHO plans relocations and in budget squeeze

The WHO is planning to relocate several units and scale back certain operations due to a 21% budget cut. The relocation includes emergency teams to Berlin, dropping some work logistics to Dubai, and workforce to Lyon. These measures aim to save up to \$3.3 million annually, alongside 600 job cuts. The organization's capacity to respond to global health crises may be compromised. While aimed at enhancing efficiency, these cuts could reduce WHO's effectiveness in addressing health emergencies worldwide, revealing the challenges faced by international organizations with limited resources.

Chinese Al startup DeepSeek releases upgraded model with domestic chip support

DeepSeek, a Chinese AI startup, introduced an upgraded version of its V3.1 model, optimized for Chinese-made chips. This version offers faster processing speeds and hybrid inference. Starting September 2025, pricing for its API will be adjusted. This model signals China's push toward technological independence. While reducing reliance on foreign tech, its expansion beyond China may face challenges due to security and privacy concerns, limiting its global reach.

Exclusive: How US alcohol tariffs may hurt some businesses, hike prices for **Americans**

The U.S. imposed new tariffs on alcohol imports from the UK and EU, including a 15% tariff on spirits and 10% on UK products like Scotch whisky. These tariffs will increase prices for American consumers and negatively impact businesses. While the tariffs are designed to support domestic production, they could raise costs for consumers and strain trade relations with Europe. The broader economic effects and their long-term impact on businesses should be closely monitored.
