No Ukraine Peace Deal, Trump Threatens Russia **Sanctions** 

U.S. President Donald Trump threatened to impose major new sanctions on Russia if no progress is made toward a peace deal in Ukraine within two weeks. He expressed frustration at the lack of results following his meeting with Russian President Vladimir Putin in Alaska, stressing that Washington is closely monitoring developments. No meeting between Putin and Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskiy has yet been arranged, leaving the conflict unresolved. Trump's approach reflects both caution and firmness-he maintains pressure through threats of sanctions while keeping the door open for a potential diplomatic settlement if tangible progress occurs.

**After Joining** TikTok, Trump May **Extend Sale Deadline** 

President Trump stated that American investors are ready to acquire TikTok's U.S. operations and hinted that he may extend the divestment deadline beyond September 17. He downplayed national security concerns, calling them exaggerated, and reiterated his support for the app, which he recently joined. Despite bipartisan criticism over data privacy and security risks, Trump said he has not yet spoken with Chinese President Xi Jinping but might do so when appropriate. This move highlights Trump's political flexibility and his willingness to leverage TikTok's popularity, while simultaneously raising heated debates over U.S. national security and technological competition with China.

**FBI Searches Home and Office** of Trump Adviser-Turned-Critic John **Bolton** 

In a high-profile move, the FBI searched the home and office of John Bolton, former national security adviser to President Donald Trump turned vocal critic. The raids are part of an investigation into his alleged mishandling of classified materials, though he has not been arrested or charged. Trump distanced himself, calling Bolton a "sleazebag," while Vice President JD Vance acknowledged that classified documents are "certainly part" of the probe and contended it is not politically motivated. The actions underscore mounting tensions between federal investigative agencies and prominent figures from the previous administration.
