US-EU tariff deal a big Trump win but not a total defeat for Brussels

After weeks of tense talks, the EU and US have struck a trade deal just before new US-China tariff talks. The agreement, driven by President Trump's personal involvement, imposes a 15% US tariff on many EU exports—less than the threatened 30%, but still a climbdown. In return, the EU will lower tariffs on US goods to zero. Europe avoided a damaging trade war but faced tough choices amid economic uncertainty and reliance on US security. The deal includes major EU purchases of US energy and arms, with Trump calling it a \$750bn investment boost and a win for American interests.

Three dead after sewage overflow causes German train to derail

Three people were killed and 41 injured after a passenger train derailed in southwest Germany due to a landslide caused by an overflowing sewage shaft following heavy rain. The crash occurred between Riedlingen and Munderkingen near Stuttgart. The train driver, a rail employee, and one passenger died. About 100 people were on board when two carriages derailed. German Chancellor Friedrich Merz expressed condolences and pledged support to emergency services. Rail traffic is suspended as investigations and cleanup begin. Photos show overturned carriages and fallen trees, with emergency teams working at the scene. Deutsche Bahn extended sympathies to victims and families.

Head monk of Shaolin 'Kung Fu' temple faces criminal probe

Shi Yongxin, abbot of China's Shaolin Temple, is under investigation for embezzlement, improper relationships, and fathering illegitimate children. The Buddhist Association of China has revoked his ordination certificate, citing severe damage to the Buddhist community's image. Known as the "CEO monk," Shi turned the 1,500-year-old temple into a global brand through schools and kung fu performances. He faced similar allegations in 2015 but was cleared. News of the probe is trending on Chinese social media. Shi's Weibo, followed by 880,000 people, has been inactive since July 24. The temple's past commercialization plans have also drawn criticism.
