Trump could meet Putin over Ukraine as soon as next week, official says

U.S. President Donald Trump may meet with Russian President Vladimir Putin as early as next week, according to a White House official. It would be the first direct meeting between sitting U.S. and Russian presidents since 2021. The discussions follow a "highly productive" meeting between Putin and U.S. special envoy Steve Witkoff. Trump remains open to a later trilateral summit including Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskiy amid looming sanctions.

India's Modi vows no compromise on farmers interests amid Trump's tariff salvo


Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi declared that he will not compromise the interests of farmers, dairy workers, and fishermen—even if it costs him personally—amid a U.S. tariff hike that raises duties on Indian goods to 50%, one of the steepest for any trading partner. The tariffs target India's continued Russian oil purchases. India's foreign ministry called the decision "extremely unfortunate," while Modi signals a shift in alliances, including a visit to China and coordination with BRICS.

Toyota warns of \$9.5 billion tariff hit, slashes annual profit forecast

Toyota Motor has cut its full-year operating profit forecast by 16%, now expecting ¥3.2 trillion (about \$21.7 billion) for the fiscal year ending March 2026, down from ¥3.8 trillion. The downgrade is due to a projected ¥1.4 trillion (\$9.5 billion) impact from U.S. tariffs, along with rising material costs and a stronger yen. Despite the hit, Toyota plans to proceed with building a new vehicle plant in Japan.
