Ukraine will not cede land, Zelenskiy says, as Trump, Putin plan meeting

President VolodymyrZelenskiy reaffirmed Ukraine's constitutional commitment to territorial integrity, declaring, "Ukrainians will not give their land to occupiers" in response to President Trump's plan to meet Vladimir Putin in Alaska on August 15. While Ukraine remains open to genuine peace solutions, Zelenskiy cautioned that any decisions made without Kyiv's involvement would be "against peace" and ultimately ineffective.

Germany halts arms exports that Israel can use in Gaza German Chancellor Friedrich Merz announced that Germany will suspend approvals for military exports to Israel that could be used in the Gaza Strip, signaling a major policy shift from long-standing support. The move responds to Israel's security cabinet approving a plan to expand operations and capture Gaza City. Germany stressed its priorities remain hostages' release, a ceasefire, and protection of civilians.

Trump announces
peace agreement
between Azerbaijan
and Armenia

Armenia and Azerbaijan signed a U.S.-brokered peace agreement at the White House under President Donald Trump, ending almost four decades of conflict over Nagorno-Karabakh. Both nations agreed to cease hostilities, establish diplomatic ties, and respect each other's borders. The deal grants the U.S. exclusive development rights to a strategic South Caucasus transit corridor—the "Trump Route"—and includes separate bilateral agreements on energy, trade, technology, and defense.
