NATO member Poland shoots down drones in its airspace during Russia's Ukraine attack

Poland, a NATO member, shot down multiple Russian drones that entered its airspace during a large-scale Russian attack on western Ukraine. Prime Minister Donald Tusk condemned the incursion as an "act of aggression"—marking the first military engagement by a NATO state in the conflict. Over ten drones were detected and neutralized, with debris searches underway. Regions including Podlaskie, Mazowieckie and Lublin were affected; residents were urged to remain indoors.

Soldiers guard Nepal's parliament, patrol streets after two days of deadly protests

Armed soldiers now guard Nepal's parliament and patrol deserted streets in Kathmandu under an indefinite curfew following two days of deadly anti-corruption protests that left 19 people dead and forced Prime Minister K.P. Sharma Oli to resign. Protesters, largely young, were enraged by a social media ban and pervasive corruption. Major government buildings were torched. The army has pledged to stabilize the situation while preparations begin for talks with protest leaders.

Wegovy-maker Novo
Nordisk to slash 9,000
jobs as competition
heats up

Novo Nordisk, maker of the weight-loss drug Wegovy and diabetes treatment Ozempic, is cutting 9,000 jobs—about 11–11.5% of its global workforce—as part of a major restructuring to save around 8 billion Danish crowns (roughly \$1.3 billion) annually amid intensifying competition, particularly from Eli Lilly, and slowing U.S. sales. The company will incur 9 billion-crown restructuring costs in Q3 but expects Q4 and annual savings. CEO Mike Doustdar aims to streamline operations, boost agility, and refocus on core therapy areas, while trimming its 2025 profit growth forecast to 4–10% from 10–16%.
