The Bank of Japan is preparing the final step of unwinding its long-running stimulus by gradually selling its huge exchange-traded fund (ETF) holdings worth about 37 trillion yen. These assets were accumulated over a decade to support the economy. The central bank aims to proceed carefully to avoid market disruption, political backlash, or heavy losses, though the exact method and timeline for sales are not yet decided.

Qatar bombing tests the limits of the Trump-Netanyahu alliance Israel's surprise airstrike on Hamas offices in Doha, Qatar—launched without warning Washington—has strained the alliance between Donald Trump and Benjamin Netanyahu. Although Trump expressed being "very unhappy" and avoiding such unilateral actions, analysts say the bombing won't fundamentally shift his pro-Israel policy. The incident exposes tensions: Netanyahu pursuing actions in Israel's perceived interests even at U.S. expense, while Trump, despite displeasure, continues supporting Israel's broader campaign.

Oil prices ease on concerns about weaker US demand, oversupply

Oil prices eased slightly amid concerns about weaker U.S. demand and oversupply risks. Rising U.S. crude and gasoline inventories signaled softer consumption, unsettling traders. OPEC+ plans to raise production in October further fueled oversupply worries. However, losses were limited by ongoing geopolitical tensions, including the Middle East conflict and Russia's war in Ukraine, which continue to support prices despite downward pressure from demand uncertainty and swelling stockpiles.
