Tens of thousands join pro-Palestinian march in New Zealand's biggest city

Tens of thousands marched in Auckland, New Zealand's largest city, in support of Palestinians during a "March for Humanity." Estimated between 20,000 and 50,000 people attended, making it the country's biggest rally since the Gaza conflict escalated in October 2023. Protesters urged sanctions on Israel and recognition of a Palestinian state. The prime minister condemned recent Israeli actions in Gaza as "utterly appalling," highlighting growing political and public pressure on the government.



Trump hosts Qatari prime minister after Israeli attack in Doha

President Trump hosted a dinner in New York with Qatari Prime Minister Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman al-Thani, following an Israeli strike in Doha targeting Hamas leaders. The meeting came after the strike threatened to derail US-backed truce talks in Gaza. Trump expressed displeasure at the unilateral attack, contacted Israeli PM Netanyahu, and reassured Qatar that such operations would not occur again. Earlier that day, al-Thani also met with Vice President J.D. Vance and Secretary of State Marco Rubio to discuss Qatar's mediator role and defense cooperation in the wake of the strike.



Nepal sets March elections after naming interim prime minister

Nepal's president dissolved parliament and set elections for March 5, 2026, after mass anti-corruption protests. Former Chief Justice Sushila Karki was appointed interim prime minister, becoming the first woman to hold the post, following the removal of K.P. Sharma Oli. The protests, led mostly by young people, erupted over a social media ban and government scandals, leaving 51 dead and over 1,300 injured before the ban was lifted.
