Fitch says Nepal's political unrest risks economic outlook, credit metrics

Fitch Ratings warned that Nepal's recent political unrest has created risks for the country's economic and fiscal outlook, with potential pressure on credit indicators. Although calm has largely returned, the unrest disrupted businesses, slowed activity, and weakened both consumer and investor confidence, reducing near-term growth prospects. Such instability can discourage investment and raise borrowing costs, highlighting the economy's sensitivity to political shocks. Sustained stability, coupled with clear fiscal and monetary policies, will be critical to restoring growth momentum and strengthening investor trust.



French President Emmanuel Macron announced that UN sanctions on Iran are expected to be reinstated before the end of the month, after recent talks with the E3 (Britain, France, Germany) were deemed insufficiently serious. The E3 launched a 30-day snapback process in late August, offering Iran more time if it restored IAEA inspections, accounted for its enriched uranium stockpiles, and entered talks with the U.S. While Tehran claims to have submitted a fair proposal, diplomats say no meaningful progress has been made.

North Korea's Kim Jong
Un oversees drone
testing, orders Al
enhancement

Kim Jong Un supervised the testing of North Korean unmanned aerial vehicles, including the 'Kumsong' tactical attack drone and a strategic reconnaissance drone, and expressed approval of the results, according to state media KCNA. He directed that drone capabilities be enhanced via artificial intelligence. Earlier this year, he had also overseen tests involving AI-powered "suicide drones." The dual focus on expanding AI integration and strengthening domestic drone tech reflects Pyongyang's drive toward modernizing its military. Such moves raise concerns among neighboring states and analysts about escalation and the growing risk of autonomous warfare.
