UK fighter jets fly over
Poland as part of
NATO's 'Eastern
Sentry' operation

British fighter jets conducted a mission over Poland on Friday to strengthen NATO's eastern flank after Russian drones violated Polish airspace earlier this month, the UK Ministry of Defense said. Two RAF Typhoon jets flew from Lincolnshire to patrol Polish skies as part of Operation Eastern Sentry, a NATO initiative launched last week in response to the breach. The operation also includes contributions from Denmark, France, and Germany. The ministry called Britain's commitment to NATO "unshakeable," stressing the mission followed what it described as the most serious violation of NATO airspace by Russia since its full-scale invasion of Ukraine in 2022.

Kirk memorial

Former President Donald Trump and other key figures will attend a memorial for Charlie Kirk, the 31-year-old conservative activist killed on 10 September during a Utah campus event. The service, organised by Turning Point USA, will be held Sunday at State Farm Stadium in Arizona, with up to 100,000 attendees expected. Speakers include Kirk's widow Erika, Vice President JD Vance, Donald Trump Jr, Tucker Carlson, and Stephen Miller. Security will be at "TSA-level," with DHS giving the event Super Bowl-level protection. Tensions remain high as the suspect, Tyler Robinson, 22, faces charges amid questions about his ideology and motive.

Morrissey cancels US shows after death threat in Canada

British singer Morrissey has cancelled two US shows after a death threat was made before his recent Ottawa concert. A 26-year-old man in Ottawa was arrested and later released on bail for allegedly threatening to kill the artist, whose real name is Steven Morrissey. Despite the threat, the Ottawa festival performance went ahead, but shows in Connecticut and Boston were later cancelled. Venue officials in Boston cited a "credible threat" and said the decision was taken for the safety of Morrissey and his band. Morrissey, former frontman of The Smiths, is known for his outspoken views on politics and animal welfare.
