Zelenskiv savs have framework security guarantees Ukrainian President Zelenskiy said Kyiv and its allies have agreed on a basic framework for security guarantees, with 26 countries signaling readiness to commit. The Paris talks, held without U.S. involvement, show Europe's push to build a collective security umbrella after any ceasefire. While details remain unclear, the plan could strengthen Ukraine's position and deter future Russian aggression, though challenges over commitments and the U.S. absence remain.

EU sticks to planned Russian oil exit bv 2028. energy chief says

The European Union has confirmed plans to phase out Russian oil by 2028, despite U.S. calls to accelerate the timeline. The move aims to cut Moscow's war revenues, but Hungary and Slovakia oppose it over costs. The EU is working with the U.S. on energy cooperation, though securing alternatives remains a challenge. If implemented, the plan could weaken Russia economically and boost EU energy independence, but may test bloc unity and require careful management of costs and supplies.

Macron says 26 nations provide ready to postwar military backing to Ukraine

After a summit of mainly European nations, Macron announced that 26 countries pledged postwar security guarantees for Ukraine, including a "reassurance force" on land, sea, and air, mostly through training and equipment rather than direct deployment. The move reflects European concerns over U.S. intentions and aims to strengthen Kyiv's security and negotiating position. Its effectiveness will depend on U.S. support, European commitments, and Russia's response; while it may deter aggression, limited troop deployment could restrict immediate impact and leave the conflict unresolved.
