Thailand's Charnvirakul PM after rout of ruling party rival **Anutin elected**

Anutin Charnvirakul's election as Thailand's prime minister marks a decisive shift away from the Shinawatra dynasty, ending a week of political deadlock. Backed by opposition alliances, he promises constitutional reforms and new elections. His minority government faces economic challenges and high household debt, while Pheu Thai vows to regain power. The victory signals a potential realignment of Thailand's political landscape and policy priorities in the coming months.

France Sovereign Rating Test Amid Political Crisis **Faces**

France faces a deep political and fiscal crisis as Macron's fragmented parliament blocks Prime Minister Bayrou's proposed 2026 budget. If Bayrou loses the September 8 confidence vote, Macron must appoint a new prime minister, likely a technocrat or center-left figure, while avoiding snap elections. Public protests, union strikes, and a potential credit rating downgrade heighten instability, making short-term fiscal reform difficult and long-term political realignment likely.

U.S. informed Europe of cuts to military aid.

The U.S. plans to cut Section 333 military aid to European countries, including the Baltic states, to zero next fiscal year, raising concerns about regional security. While troop deployments and other programs remain unaffected, the move may force Europe to increase defense spending and seek greater self-reliance. Short-term uncertainty and long-term shifts in U.S.-European security cooperation are likely.
