Suspected plot to attack Belgian PM foiled

Belgian police have arrested three people suspected of plotting a “jihadist-inspired terrorist attack” against Prime Minister Bart De Wever and other politicians. Authorities discovered a suspected improvised explosive device and evidence of plans to use a drone during raids in Deurne, Antwerp, near the prime minister’s residence. The suspects, born between 2001 and 2007, were charged with attempted terrorist murder and participation in a terrorist group. One has been released, while two remain in custody. Prosecutors said Belgium has opened 80 terrorism investigations so far this year — surpassing last year’s total — highlighting a growing security threat.

New York Attorney General Letitia James criminally indicted

New York Attorney General Letitia James has been indicted on federal charges of bank fraud and making false statements to a financial institution, according to court documents filed in Virginia. Prosecutors allege she falsified information related to a mortgage loan for a property in Norfolk. James, who previously led a civil fraud case against Trump, said the charges are politically motivated, accusing the president of weaponizing the justice system in retaliation. She called the allegations “baseless,” while U.S. prosecutor Lindsey Halligan said the case shows “no one is above the law” and represents “serious breaches of public trust.”

Green turtle bounces back from brink in conservation 'win'

The green turtle, once hunted nearly to extinction for its meat, eggs, and shells, has made a remarkable recovery thanks to decades of conservation efforts. Once listed as endangered since the 1980s, new data now shows populations are rebounding globally. Scientists credit measures such as protecting nesting sites, releasing hatchlings, and reducing accidental capture in fishing nets. Dr. Nicolas Pilcher of Malaysia’s Marine Research Foundation called it a “major win” and urged continued action. Conservationist Prof. Brendan Godley said the turtles’ recovery offers hope, highlighting how years of global dedication to protecting these iconic sea creatures are finally paying off.
