Eighteen missing after explosion at Tennessee munitions

At least 18 people are missing after a massive explosion destroyed a military explosives factory in Bucksnort, Tennessee, about 90km southwest of Nashville. Sheriff Chris Davis said several people were taken to hospital and that "multiple are deceased." The blast leveled the Accurate Energetic Systems facility, which develops and stores explosives, scattering debris over half a square mile. Secondary explosions forced rescuers to keep their distance. Authorities have not determined whether the explosion was accidental or intentional. Tennessee Governor Bill Lee called it a "tragic incident" and said state and federal agencies are assisting in the investigation and response.

Qatar to build air force facility in Idaho, US says

The US has finalized an agreement allowing Qatar to build an air force training facility at Mountain Home Airbase in Idaho, where Qatari pilots will be trained to fly F-15 fighter jets.US Defence Secretary Pete Hegseth announced the deal during a meeting with Qatari Defence Minister Saoud bin Abdulrahman al-Thani, calling it "another example of our partnership. He praised Qatar's "substantial role" in mediation efforts between Israel and Hamas.The facility will host Qatari F-15s and pilots to enhance joint training and interoperability.Details about the number of aircraft and the operational date were not disclosed.

Melania Trump

Ukrainian children

US First Lady Melania Trump announced that Russian President Vladimir Putin responded to her letter urging protection for children affected by the Russia-Ukraine war. She said that following their "open communication," eight Ukrainian children were reunited with their families within 24 hours. Her "peace letter," hand-delivered during Putin's Alaska visit in August, appealed for the safety of displaced children. Mrs. Trump said both Ukraine and Russia cooperated in the reunifications and that she received verified reports with photos. The First Lady called the development a "humanitarian success" and part of her long-standing BE BEST initiative to promote children's well-being.
