Israel will allow Gaza's Rafah crossing to open, ramp up aid, broadcaster Kan reports

Israel has agreed to reopen the Rafah crossing with Egypt, allow humanitarian aid into Gaza, and permit some displaced people to return or exit, according to Israeli public broadcaster Kan. This shift follows exchanges by Hamas of bodies of deceased hostages; Israel had previously threatened to keep the crossing closed due to non-compliance by Hamas with ceasefire terms.

Bangladesh garment factory fire kills 16, toll may rise

A fire broke out on October 14 in Dhaka, Bangladesh, destroying a garment factory and adjacent chemical warehouse. At least 16 people are confirmed dead, and the death toll may rise as rescue efforts continue. The blaze began on the third floor and spread rapidly, fueled by materials like bleaching powder and hydrogen peroxide stored nearby. Authorities have yet to determine a cause or whether the warehouse was legally licensed.

US strike on alleged drug boat off Venezuela kills six, Trump says

A U.S. military strike on a boat off Venezuela killed six individuals, President Trump announced, claiming they were tied to drug trafficking and “narcoterrorist networks.” The vessel was struck in international waters, and Trump released video footage of the explosion. Legal experts are questioning whether these strikes—part of a broader campaign by the U.S.—comply with international law.
