Colombia accuses US of murder after strike on boat Colombian President Gustavo Petro accused the United States of "murder" after a US strike hit a Colombian boat in national waters in September, allegedly killing a fisherman. Petro said the vessel was adrift with a distress signal due to engine failure, calling the strike a violation of sovereignty and demanding explanations from Washington. The accusation followed President Donald Trump's claim that US forces destroyed a "drug-carrying submarine" loaded with fentanyl and other narcotics, killing two people. The attack was reportedly the sixth US strike on ships in the Caribbean in recent weeks, which UN experts condemned as extrajudicial killings.

US warns Hamas is planning 'imminent' attack on Gaza civilians in breach of ceasefire

The US warned it has "credible reports" that Hamas is planning an "imminent" attack on civilians in Gaza, calling it a "grave breach" of the ceasefire deal. Washington said such an attack would undermine mediation efforts and urged Hamas to uphold the truce. Hamas dismissed the claims as false. The warning comes amid reports of Hamas gunfights with local clans as it reasserts control after Israel's partial withdrawal. Under the US-brokered deal, all living hostages have been freed and 250 Palestinian prisoners released. Israel says Rafah crossing will stay closed until Hamas returns remaining bodies of Israeli hostages.

The Bali-fication of a laidback surfers' island

Located east of Bali, Lombok is known for its stunning blue beaches and scenic landscapes, making it a favorite destination for surfers and hikers exploring Mount Rinjani. Yet, it still retains its image as an "untouched" island compared to crowded Bali. This natural charm has drawn the attention of the Indonesian government, which aims to turn Lombok into a "new Bali" as part of its "10 New Balis" tourism initiative. Mandalika, in the island's south, has been chosen as the development hub, featuring luxury resorts, cafes, and a racing circuit. However, dozens of families were evicted between 2019 and 2021 amid complaints of unfair compensation.
