Zelensky ready to join Trump-Putin talks after 'frank' White House meeting

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky said he would be ready to join Donald Trump and Vladimir Putin at a proposed summit in Hungary if invited. The US and Russian presidents plan to hold talks on the Ukraine war in Budapest in the coming weeks. Zelensky said he was open to “any format” but criticised Hungary’s Prime Minister Viktor Orban for being unhelpful to Ukraine. Reports said Zelensky’s meeting with Trump at the White House turned into a “shouting match,” with Trump urging Kyiv to accept Russia’s terms. Zelensky said his goal was a just peace, not a quick one, and left without securing Tomahawk missiles.

Louvre heist creates 'terrible image' of France, justice minister says

French Justice Minister Gérald Darmanin condemned a major jewellery heist at Paris’s Louvre museum, saying security measures “failed” and damaged France’s image. Thieves used power tools to steal eight priceless items, including a diamond and emerald necklace given to Napoleon’s wife, escaping on scooters. Authorities fear the jewels could be dismantled and smuggled abroad if not recovered quickly. Chris Marinello of Art Recovery International warned that within 24–48 hours, the stolen crowns and diadems could be irretrievably altered, melted, or recut, making recovery nearly impossible. The museum remained closed Monday as police investigated the audacious daylight theft.

Teacher who killed eight-year-old jailed for life in South Korea

A South Korean court sentenced teacher Myeong Jae-wan to life imprisonment for fatally stabbing eight-year-old Kim Hae-neul in Daejeon. Myeong, 48, lured the girl into a classroom in February, intending to kill herself and a random child. Prosecutors sought the death penalty, but the court cited mental health issues and difficulty in concluding execution was necessary. Myeong showed remorse through letters and will wear an electronic tracking device for 30 years. The court condemned her breach of trust as a teacher, stating she failed to protect a child where they should feel safest.
