

The Paris prosecutor's office announced arrests on Saturday evening following the daring Louvre heist, though no number was disclosed. One suspect was reportedly preparing to travel to Algeria and another to Mali. The prosecutor condemned the early release of case details, saying it hindered efforts to recover the stolen jewels. The thieves arrived at 09:30, using a vehicle-mounted lift to access the Galerie d'Apollon through a window near the Seine. Armed with power tools, they cut through glass cases, threatened guards, and escaped on scooters at 09:38. Reports revealed that one-third of nearby museum rooms lacked CCTV coverage.

Harris 'concerned' she did not ask Biden to quit race Former US Vice-President Kamala Harris told the BBC she regrets not urging Joe Biden to withdraw from the 2024 race, reflecting that "perhaps" she should have spoken to him about his ability to endure a tough campaign. In her book 107 Days, Harris said Biden's decision to run again "shouldn't have been left to an individual's ego." She clarified her concern was about his stamina, not his competence as president, noting the demands of running against Donald Trump. Harris said she hesitated to speak up to avoid appearing self-interested. She also hinted she may run for president again.



Donald Trump announced a 10% tariff increase on Canadian imports after Ontario aired an anti-tariff ad featuring Ronald Reagan. The US president called the advert a "fraud" and criticised Canadian officials for not removing it before the World Series. Ontario's premier said the ad would be pulled in Canada to resume trade talks but would still air in the US over the weekend. The dispute comes as Canada remains the only G7 nation without a trade deal with the US since Trump began imposing steep tariffs on major partners, escalating tensions between Washington and Ottawa ahead of negotiations.
