Trump authorises
deployment of
300 National
Guard troops to
Chicago

President Donald Trump has authorised the deployment of 300 National Guard troops to Chicago, citing surging crime. The decision follows an incident where immigration agents shot an armed woman during a clash with protesters. Illinois Governor JB Pritzker condemned the move as an attempt to "manufacture a crisis." Meanwhile, a federal judge in Portland blocked Trump's plan to send 200 troops there, ruling it unconstitutional and warning it blurred the line between civil and military power. Judge Karin Immergut said the deployment risked inflaming unrest and undermining state sovereignty. Legal challenges are expected if troops enter Chicago.

Poland
scrambles jets
as Russia strikes
western Ukraine

Russia launched overnight missile and drone strikes across Ukraine, focusing on the western city of Lviv. Two people were killed and two injured in the region, while a separate attack on a power plant in Zaporizhzhia left one dead and over 73,000 without electricity. Poland scrambled fighter jets and raised air defences amid the assault, with NATO aircraft also active. Lviv's mayor reported power outages and halted public transport after heavy air defence engagement. The attacks come days after Washington signalled support for Ukrainian strikes inside Russia, as Moscow intensifies its campaign against Ukraine's energy infrastructure.



Meghan makes surprise appearance at Paris Fashion Week The Duchess of Sussex, Meghan Markle, made a solo appearance at Paris Fashion Week on Saturday to support designer Pierpaolo Piccioli, Balenciaga's new creative director. Wearing a white Balenciaga ensemble with wide-leg trousers, a matching blazer, and black heels, Meghan attended the show for the first time in over a decade. Her spokesperson said the visit reflected her admiration for Piccioli's "craftsmanship and modern elegance." Meghan was seen greeting Vogue's Anna Wintour and filmmaker Baz Luhrmann at the event. She shared her arrival in Paris on Instagram, highlighting her long-standing collaboration and friendship with the designer.
