Europeans push back at US plan that would force concessions from Ukraine

European countries pushed back against a reported U.S.-backed peace plan for Ukraine that would require Kyiv to cede more territory and accept limits on its armed forces, terms many allies see as near capitulation. Reuters sources say Washington has signalled to President Volodymyr Zelenskiy that he should accept this U.S.-drafted framework. The move comes as Ukraine struggles militarily and Zelenskiy's government faces a corruption scandal. Moscow downplayed any new U.S. initiative, insisting no real consultations are underway and repeating its long-standing demands.

Edgy Iran seeks revive stalled US

Iran has asked Saudi Arabia to help persuade the U.S. to revive stalled nuclear talks, reflecting Tehran's concern over renewed Israeli strikes and economic pressure. Before Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman's White House visit, Saudi leverage to President Masoud Pezeshkian sent him a letter saying Iran does not seek confrontation and is open to a diplomatic nuclear deal if its rights are nuclear talks with guaranteed. A Gulf source said Iran hopes Riyadh can open a channel to Washington, while MbS told Trump he wants a peaceful resolution. Analysts say Saudi Arabia's close U.S. ties and regional clout make it a key mediator.

EU to toughen trade stance on pivots

French authorities have arrested several suspects over the October 19, 2025 Louvre jewel heist, when thieves stole eight pieces of the French Crown Jewels worth about €88 million in a raid lasting under eight minutes. One man was detained at Charles de Gaulle Airport as he tried to board a flight to Algeria, China as Germany after DNA linked him to a helmet left at the scene. Another suspect was arrested in the Paris suburbs; both have partially admitted involvement and face organised theft and conspiracy charges. More accomplices are believed to be at large, and the stolen jewels remain missing.
