Oil prices fell for a third straight session as the U.S. pushes a Russia-Ukraine peace plan that could eventually boost global supply. Brent slipped to about \$39 a barrel and WTI to \$57.90, with both benchmarks on track for weekly losses above 2%. A stronger dollar and expectations that the Federal Reserve will delay rate cuts also pressured prices. Markets remain cautious, as any peace accord is uncertain and doubts persist over the impact of new U.S. sanctions on Rosneft and Lukoil.

EU opens case against Slovakia over constitutional change The European Commission has launched a legal case against Slovakia over a recent constitutional amendment that says national laws take precedence over EU law in areas like family, gender and national identity. Brussels says this violates the primacy of EU law, a core principle of the bloc, and has sent Bratislava a formal notice; Slovakia has two months to respond. Prime Minister Robert Fico refuses to change the constitution, prompting fears among pro-EU opponents that he is paving the way for a possible EU exit.



India and Afghanistan will soon launch air cargo services to boost trade after Pakistan closed its border with Afghanistan following military clashes. Kabul wants better access to Indian grains, medicines and industrial goods, and India has now activated air freight corridors linking Kabul with Delhi and Amritsar. An Indian foreign ministry official said New Delhi has completed its formalities and is waiting for Afghan paperwork. The move comes as both countries recalibrate ties despite India not recognising the Taliban government.
