US and Russia to hold Ukraine talks in Abu Dhabi after overnight strikes Russia and Ukraine exchanged overnight drone strikes, killing at least six in Kyiv and three in Russia's Rostov region. The attacks coincided with US confirmation that officials would meet Russian representatives in Abu Dhabi to advance peace efforts. Ukrainian President Zelensky welcomed proposed revisions to the controversial 28-point US peace plan, developed after European allies rejected elements seen as favouring Russia. Kyiv's security chief said Zelensky's US visit may soon be arranged to negotiate with President Trump. The Kremlin dismissed the amendments as "completely unconstructive," while Ukraine's European allies plan a virtual meeting to coordinate next steps in the peace process.

Nine arrested in India after police crack \$800,000 bank heist Nine people have been arrested in Bengaluru, India, following a daring 70 million rupee (\$800,000) heist in which armed men posing as central bank officials stole cash from an ATM van. Police recovered 68.5 million rupees and continue investigating. The gang stopped the van under the pretense of checking paperwork, forced the cash custodian and two guards into an SUV, and drove off with the money, later changing vehicles and using fake plates. Earlier arrests include a cash transport employee, a former worker, and a local constable. Police are probing CMS's role and adherence to cash transport guidelines.

Adolescence
lasts into 30s new study shows
four pivotal ages
for your brain

Scientists have identified five distinct phases of brain development, with key turning points at ages nine, 32, 66, and 83. A study of around 4,000 people up to age 90 used brain scans to map neural connections, revealing that the brain remains in the adolescent phase until the early thirties, when it peaks. The five phases are childhood (0–9), adolescence (9–32), adulthood (32–66), early ageing (66–83), and late ageing (83+). Researchers say the findings explain fluctuations in mental health and dementia risk over a lifetime. The study, published in Nature Communications, highlights the brain's constant rewiring and adaptation to experience.
