US suspends immigration requests for Afghans after National Guard shooting

The US has halted all immigration requests from Afghan nationals pending a review of security and vetting procedures, following a shooting near the White House that critically injured two National Guard soldiers. The suspected attacker, identified as 29-year-old Afghan national Rahmanullah Lakanwal, entered the US in 2021 under Operation Allies Welcome. President Donald Trump labelled the incident an “act of terror” and pledged to remove foreigners “who do not belong here”. The suspension adds to earlier travel bans and the termination of deportation protections for Afghans, many of whom had entered the US after the 2021 withdrawal from Afghanistan.

Soldiers seize power in Guinea-Bissau and detain the president

A group of military officers has seized control of Guinea-Bissau and reportedly arrested President Umaro Sissoco Embaló. Gunfire was heard in the capital, Bissau, before officers appeared on state TV announcing a takeover, suspension of the electoral process, border closures, and a night curfew. They claimed they were preventing a plot backed by a “well-known drug baron.” Election results from Sunday’s vote were expected Thursday, with both Embaló and rival Fernando Dias claiming victory. Government sources say Dias, former PM Domingos Pereira, the interior minister, and top army commanders have also been detained. Portugal urged a return to constitutional order.

Woman killed in shark attack in Australia

A woman in her 20s has died and a man of similar age was critically injured after a shark attack at Kylies Beach in New South Wales, Australia. The man was airlifted to Newcastle Hospital, with authorities praising a bystander who applied a makeshift tourniquet that likely saved his life. Officials said the attacker was likely a large bull shark, a species known for its danger to humans. The beach and nearby areas have been closed, with drones and “smart” drumlines deployed. This marks Australia’s fifth fatal shark attack this year, the latest occurring less than three months ago.
