Death toll hits 212 as Sri Lanka struggles with Cyclone Ditwah impact Sri Lanka's death toll from Cyclone Ditwah has risen to 212, with 218 people still missing, as floods and landslides continue to devastate the country. Nearly one million residents have been affected, and close to 200,000 people have taken refuge in over 1,200 shelters. Rescue teams—over 24,000 police, military, and air force personnel—are working to reach stranded families, especially after a dam breach at the Mavil Aru Reservoir forced emergency airlifts and evacuations. Colombo remains among the hardest-hit areas, where thousands await assistance. Authorities expect floodwaters to gradually recede in the coming days as the cyclone moves toward southern India.

Ukraine hits two Russian 'shadow fleet' oil tankers with naval drones Ukrainian naval drones struck two sanctioned oil tankers, Kairos and Virat, in the Black Sea as they headed toward the Russian port of Novorossiysk. The attacks caused fires and severe damage that reportedly took both vessels out of service. Targeting tankers marks a new tactic by Kyiv to disrupt Russia's shadow fleet used to evade sanctions. Separately, the Caspian Pipeline Consortium halted operations after drone damage to its Black Sea mooring, drawing criticism from Kazakhstan.

Kazakhstan tells
Ukraine to stop
attacking CPC
terminal after oil
exports halted

Kazakhstan urged Ukraine on Sunday to stop attacking the Caspian Pipeline Consortium's Black Sea terminal after a major drone strike halted exports and severely damaged key loading infrastructure. The CPC, which handles over 1% of global oil and has Russian, Kazakh, and U.S. shareholders, suspended operations following significant damage to one of its moorings. Ukraine has carried out repeated strikes this year on Russian oil refineries and export facilities to weaken a critical source of revenue for Moscow's war effort. Kazakhstan condemned the latest attack, calling it the third wave targeting what it described as an exclusively civilian facility protected under international law.
