

Russia says
NATO remarks
on pre-emptive
strike are
irresponsible
and escalatory

Russia condemned NATO's remarks on considering a "pre-emptive strike," calling them "extremely irresponsible" and escalatory. NATO's top military officer, Admiral Giuseppe Cavo Dragone, had suggested that the U.S.-led alliance might consider such a strike as a "defensive action" in response to Moscow's hybrid warfare tactics. Russian Foreign Ministry spokeswoman Maria Zakharova warned that those making such statements should recognize the potential risks and consequences, including for NATO members themselves. A Russian missile attack on Dnipro, Ukraine, has killed four people and injured 40. Reports suggest a ballistic missile was used in the strike, which hit a motorway, office block, cars, and shops. Dnipro, about 100 km from the front line, has been frequently attacked since Russia's invasion in February 2022. The attack occurred a day before US special envoy Steve Witkoff was due to meet President Putin for peace talks. Despite ongoing negotiations, significant differences remain. Zelensky faces political challenges at home amid a corruption scandal and ongoing war casualties.

Hong Kong arrests more suspects in fire probe as death toll hits 151 Hong Kong authorities arrested 13 people for suspected manslaughter in connection with the city's deadliest fire in decades, which claimed at least 151 lives. The fire, which occurred at Wang Fuk Court estate, was fueled by substandard renovation materials, including green mesh and foam insulation that failed to meet fire safety standards. Police continue to search the burnt-out towers, finding bodies of residents trapped in stairwells and rooftops. Thousands have paid tribute to the victims, including domestic helpers from Indonesia and the Philippines. Meanwhile, Beijing warned against protests calling for an independent investigation.
