👉 Thai defence minister to attend truce talks with Cambodia, PM says

Thailand's defence minister will join Cambodia in truce talks on Saturday, Prime Minister Anutin Charnvirakul said, as border clashes enter a fourth week. Fighting has killed about 98 people and displaced more than half a million. Anutin urged both sides to honour commitments to avoid provocation and lower hostility. The deal could mirror a ceasefire framework brokered with U.S. President Donald Trump, but that truce collapsed in early December despite mediation by Malaysia's Anwar Ibrahim and a Chinese envoy.

👉 Zelenskiy says he will meet Trump on Sunday to discuss Ukraine territory, guarantees

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskiy said he will meet U.S. President Donald Trump on Sunday in Florida to discuss key elements of a possible settlement to Russia's war: territorial questions and security guarantees for Ukraine. Zelenskiy said negotiators are close to finalising agreements, including a broader peace framework, and wants to lock in "as much as possible" before year-end. The talks come as diplomacy accelerates despite continuing Russian strikes and unresolved disputes over occupied areas. European partners may be consulted virtually.

👉 India's water crunch brews risks for beverage giants

India's worsening water scarcity is creating operational and reputational risk for global brewers and spirits makers in Rajasthan, where aquifers are over-exploited and many residents get piped water only weekly. Liquor transport limits between states effectively force firms such as Heineken, Carlsberg and Diageo to keep local plants to sell there. Though they use a small share of water, they draw scrutiny and legal complaints. Companies are boosting efficiency, harvesting rainwater and funding community replenishment projects amid a nationwide squeeze.
