Tunisians Rally Against Saied's Crackdown

Tunisians protested in central Tunis for a third consecutive week against President Kais Saied's widening crackdown on opposition figures, critics, and civil society groups, demanding the release of political detainees. Rights groups accuse Saied of using the judiciary and police to silence opponents and entrench one-man rule. The demonstrations intensified after an appeals court handed prison sentences of up to 45 years to dozens of opposition leaders, businesspeople, and lawyers accused of plotting to overthrow him. Protesters carried banners calling for freedom and chanted slogans from Tunisia's 2011 revolution. The UGTT union has also called a nationwide strike on January 21.

Macron Meets Zelenskiy, Starmer & Merz in London

Macron said he will travel to London on Monday to meet Zelenskiy and the British and German leaders to discuss the war in Ukraine and U.S.-mediated talks. He reaffirmed France's support for Ukraine and said security guarantees are essential for a lasting peace and Europe's security. Macron condemned overnight strikes on Ukraine's energy and rail infrastructure. The IAEA said the attacks disrupted the power grid, forced some nuclear plants to reduce output, and briefly cut off external power to the Zaporizhzhia nuclear plant.

Bolsonaro's Son Signals 2026 Run Backing

Senator Flavio Bolsonaro said his father, former Brazilian President Jair Bolsonaro, has endorsed him as the right-wing Liberal Party's candidate for Brazil's 2026 presidential election. Party leader Valdemar Costa Neto confirmed the decision, despite Jair Bolsonaro serving time over a failed coup plot. The announcement unsettled markets, with Brazil's currency falling as much as 3% against the dollar and the Bovespa stock index dropping about 4%, as investors had expected a more established candidate to lead the right.
