Mock house, CIA source and Special Forces: The US operation to capture Maduro

President Donald Trump said the United States carried out “Operation Absolute Resolve” to capture Venezuelan President Nicolás Maduro and his wife. Months of planning reportedly included Delta Force rehearsals on a replica of Maduro’s safe house, CIA surveillance and an asset close to him. After Trump’s final approval late Friday, U.S. aircraft struck military targets around Caracas while special forces moved in. The Pentagon had surged ships, aircraft and troops to the Caribbean under anti-drug operations. Officials said Maduro and his wife surrendered and were flown out to the USS Iwo Jima, with no U.S. deaths reported overnight.

Police identify 16 more victims of Swiss bar fire

Police have identified 16 additional victims from the bar fire at Le Constellation in the Swiss ski resort of Crans-Montana, bringing the confirmed death toll to 24. The youngest was a 14-year-old Swiss girl, and nine of those identified were under 18. Victims include Swiss, Italian, Romanian, Turkish and French nationals. A criminal investigation is examining those who ran the venue, while families still await news of people listed as missing. Among the dead is 16-year-old Arthur Brodard, whose mother confirmed his death online and asked for privacy. Police said they will withhold more details to respect victims’ relatives’ privacy.

UK and France bomb underground IS arms bunker in Syria

Royal Air Force Typhoon jets joined French aircraft in a late-Saturday strike on an underground arms cache in mountains north of Palmyra, Syria, the UK Ministry of Defence said. Intelligence suggested the facility was storing weapons and explosives for Islamic State (IS). The Typhoons used Paveway IV guided bombs to hit access tunnels, with initial indications the target was successfully engaged and no civilians were harmed. The UK said the operation supports ongoing efforts to prevent any IS resurgence after its 2019 defeat, while the UN estimates 5,000-7,000 IS fighters remain in Syria and Iraq.
