👉 **Greenland says 'no more fantasies about annexation' after Trump remarks**

Greenland's leader said "enough is enough" as European allies backed Denmark, insisting the Arctic island's future must be decided by Greenlanders after Donald Trump again floated acquiring it. Trump, a day after hailing a U.S. raid that captured Venezuela's Nicolás Maduro and saying Washington would oversee governance there, revived Danish fears of similar pressure on Greenland. He told The Atlantic the U.S. "needs" Greenland for defence and said he would revisit the issue. Denmark cites Greenland's strategic location for missile defence and its mineral resources; Finland, France and allies voiced support, and Denmark's PM said annexation talk made no sense.

👉 **Ten people convicted for cyber-bullying of France's first lady Brigitte Macron**

A Paris court convicted 10 people of cyber-harassing France's first lady, Brigitte Macron, after they spread false claims that she is a transgender woman and that she was born "Jean-Michel Trogneux" (the name of her older brother). French media said eight men and two women posted malicious remarks about her gender and sexuality and received sentences of up to eight months' suspended jail time. The ruling supports the Macrons' broader legal push, including a U.S. defamation suit against influencer Candace Owens. Brigitte Macron said she is fighting online abuse to set an example, especially for adolescents.

👉 **Maduro at troubled Brooklyn jail that once held Ghislaine Maxwell**

Captured in Caracas, ousted Venezuelan President Nicolás Maduro and his wife, Cilia Flores, were flown to the United States and taken to the Metropolitan Detention Center in Brooklyn ahead of Monday court appearances on drug-trafficking charges. The jail, New York City's only federal pretrial facility, has drawn repeated complaints about harsh and unsanitary conditions, though the Bureau of Prisons says reforms and staffing have improved matters. Former officials and lawyers say high-profile detainees can face elevated security risks and expect Maduro to be kept apart from other inmates, with extended daily lockdown and tightly controlled contact inside a high-security unit.
