Trump briefed on military and covert options for Iran



President Donald Trump has been briefed on a broad range of covert and military options for dealing with Iran, according to two US Defense Department officials. These include potential long-range missile strikes, as well as cyber operations and psychological campaigns. The developments come after Trump announced a 25% tariff on goods from countries trading with Iran, amid reports that more than 600 protesters have been killed during recent anti-government demonstrations. While Iran's foreign minister has said Tehran is open to talks with Washington, he also warned the country remains prepared for war, as US officials consider possible next steps.

Minnesota sues Trump administration to block surge of ICE agents



The US state of Minnesota has filed a lawsuit against the Trump administration seeking to block the deployment of large numbers of federal immigration agents, arguing the move is unconstitutional and has caused widespread disruption. The legal action follows the fatal shooting of a woman by an immigration agent in Minneapolis and the protests that erupted afterward. State officials say the deployment has created fear and chaos, while the Trump administration has dismissed the lawsuit as baseless, insisting the agents are needed to combat illegal immigration and ensure officer safety.

Oil extends climb on Iran supply disruption concerns



Oil prices rose on Tuesday as fears of supply disruptions linked to escalating unrest in Iran outweighed expectations of higher output from Venezuela. Brent crude climbed to about \$64.34 a barrel, near a two-month high, while US WTI reached nearly \$60. The gains were driven by growing protests in Iran, a major OPEC producer, and concerns over possible US intervention after President Donald Trump warned of military action and threatened tariffs on countries trading with Tehran. Analysts noted uncertainty over whether Washington would escalate tensions, especially given the recent US-China trade truce.
