**Around 1,500  
soldiers on standby  
for deployment to  
Minneapolis**

US defence officials say about 1,500 active-duty soldiers are on standby in Alaska for a possible deployment to Minnesota amid growing protests over the fatal shooting of Renee Good by an ICE agent. The Pentagon has prepared the Arctic-trained troops in case President Donald Trump decides to use them to help manage unrest in Minneapolis and St. Paul linked to anti-immigration enforcement actions. No final decision has yet been made on sending the soldiers to the state. The move comes alongside large federal deployments and heightened tensions between local authorities and the Trump administration.

**Ugandan leader  
extends 40-year  
rule after winning  
contested poll**

Uganda's President Yoweri Museveni has been declared the winner of Thursday's election, extending his rule to nearly 40 years with a reported 72% of the vote. His main challenger, opposition leader Bobi Wine, received 25% and rejected the results, alleging fraud and ballot stuffing, claims denied by authorities and not supported by African Union observers. The election was marred by violence, with Wine saying at least 21 people were killed, while officials confirmed seven deaths. Internet access was cut, celebrations were muted, and sporadic violence was reported in parts of the capital, Kampala.

**Avalanches kill five  
off-piste skiers in  
Austrian Alps**

Five off-piste skiers have died in two avalanches in Austria's Alps following heavy snowfall. Four people were killed and one seriously injured when an avalanche struck a group of skiers in the Pongau region near Salzburg, while another skier died in a separate incident earlier the same day. Authorities say avalanche conditions are currently extremely dangerous. Similar fatal incidents have been reported across the Alps in recent days, including in Austria, Switzerland and France, highlighting the growing risks caused by severe winter weather.
