Clintons agree to testify on Epstein as vote looms to hold them in contempt of Congress

Bill Clinton and Hillary Clinton have agreed to testify in a House Oversight Committee investigation involving the late Jeffrey Epstein, ending a months-long standoff that had prompted plans to vote on holding them in criminal contempt. Their lawyers initially offered limited testimony, but chairman James Comer questioned whether Bill Clinton would evade questions; lawmakers have now postponed contempt consideration while terms are clarified. Bill Clinton acknowledges contact and four flights on Epstein's jet in 2002–03 tied to Clinton Foundation work, but denies any knowledge of wrongdoing and says he cut ties long ago. Hillary Clinton says she never met Epstein.



Trump calls on Republicans to 'nationalize' future elections

Donald Trump urged Republicans to “nationalize voting” in an interview with Dan Bongino, saying the party should “take over” voting administration in around 15 places. His remarks came after the Federal Bureau of Investigation searched an elections office in Fulton County, linked to a US Department of Justice effort to seize election records and look into alleged fraud connected to the 2020 election he lost to Joe Biden. Tulsi Gabbard said the president directed her to go to Atlanta and spoke by phone with agents involved. The comments also come as his administration pushes changes to registration and mail-voting rules ahead of the midterms.



Celebrities like Pedro Pascal and Billie Eilish begin to condemn deadly shootings in Minneapolis amid ICE surge

After weeks of relative silence, Hollywood figures spoke out after ICU nurse Alex Pretti was killed in Minneapolis during a confrontation with federal agents. Pedro Pascal and Billie Eilish amplified the case on social media, sharing posts that also highlighted the shooting of Renee Good and citing a The New York Times call for transparency. Jamie Lee Curtis and Edward Norton echoed renewed messages supporting a general strike. At the Sundance Film Festival, Natalie Portman and Olivia Wilde wore “ICE Out” pins and condemned the violence. Mark Ruffalo and Glenn Close also denounced federal actions, urging pressure, accountability, and political engagement.
