PM asks Sir Jim Ratcliffe to apologise for saying UK 'colonised by immigrants'

UK Prime Minister Keir Starmer condemned comments by Manchester United co-owner Sir Jim Ratcliffe that the UK has been “colonised by immigrants,” calling them “offensive and wrong” and urging him to apologise. Downing Street said the remarks fuel division, while multiple Manchester United fan groups and anti-racism organisations also criticised them. Ratcliffe defended his stance by linking immigration and welfare to economic strain, though official population data disputes some of the figures he cited. Politicians across parties reacted, with Reform UK’s Nigel Farage backing the sentiment and others calling it un-British and divisive.

Police identify suspect in Canada mass shooting as investigation continues

Police in British Columbia identified 18-year-old Jesse Van Rootselaar as the suspect in the Tumbler Ridge shootings. Authorities say the attack left eight victims dead and more than 25 injured, and the suspect was found dead at the scene. Police said they had previously responded to the suspect’s home for mental-health checks and recovered two firearms. Investigators say the motive remains unclear and believe the suspect acted alone.

Trump says no 'definitive' agreement with Netanyahu, US talks with Iran to continue

President Donald Trump said talks with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu produced no “definitive” agreement on how to proceed with Iran, but he insisted U.S. negotiations with Tehran will continue to pursue a deal. Netanyahu pressed for any diplomacy to address not only Iran’s nuclear program but also its missiles and support for regional proxies, while Iran says its missile capabilities are non-negotiable. Trump again warned of potential strikes if no agreement is reached. The leaders also discussed Gaza, where ceasefire and reconstruction efforts have stalled amid disputes over Hamas disarmament and phased Israeli withdrawal.
