US reveals new details of alleged Chinese nuclear test

A U.S. official said evidence suggests China carried out an underground nuclear test at Lop Nor on June 22, 2020. Assistant Secretary of State Christopher Yeaw cited a Kazakhstan seismic station that detected a magnitude-2.75 “explosion” 720 km away, arguing it was neither mining nor an earthquake and matched a nuclear blast, possibly masked by “decoupling.” The CTBTO reported two tiny events 12 seconds apart, far below its confident-detection threshold, so it could not verify the claim. China called the allegation unfounded and political. New START’s expiry heightens arms-race fears; Pentagon estimates China has 600+ warheads, projecting 1,000 by 2030.

Microsoft says it is on pace to invest \$50 billion in 'Global South' AI push

Microsoft said it is on track to invest \$50 billion by the end of the decade to help expand AI across countries in the “Global South.” The announcement came at the AI summit in New Delhi, where executives from leading AI companies are meeting world leaders this week. The “Global South” refers to developing, emerging, or lower-income countries, many in the southern hemisphere. Microsoft also highlighted its recent push in India, where it unveiled \$17.5 billion in AI investments last year as it deepened its bet on one of the world’s fastest-growing digital markets.

How well a cancer treatment works may depend on the time of day you get it

Researchers tested whether timing affects cancer immunotherapy. In a randomized trial of 210 non-small-cell lung cancer patients (Nature Medicine), half received initial PD-1 inhibitor infusions before 3 p.m., half after. Earlier dosing was linked to markedly better outcomes: progression-free survival averaged 11.3 months vs 5.7 months, and overall survival was nearly a year longer; about 45% of early-treated patients were alive at study end vs ~15% of late group. Scientists suspect circadian rhythms make immune T cells more active and more present in tumors in the morning. Experts call results compelling but urge replication; confirmatory trials are underway.
