PM says 'nobody is above the law' over Andrew allegations

UK Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer said “nobody is above the law” when asked about new allegations involving Andrew Mountbatten-Windsor, adding that any decision on questioning is for police. Thames Valley Police and other forces are assessing claims and possible offences linked to his contacts with Jeffrey Epstein, including whether sensitive documents were shared. Starmer said he would not block a parliamentary debate and repeated that anyone with relevant information, including Andrew, should testify to the appropriate body in the US. Andrew denies wrongdoing.



US military prepared to strike Iran as early as this weekend, but Trump has yet to make a final call,

US forces are reportedly positioned to carry out strikes on Iran as early as this weekend, though President Donald Trump has not issued a final order. The White House has reviewed military readiness after a surge of US air and naval deployments in the Middle East, and senior officials have met to weigh options. Meanwhile, indirect US-Iran talks in Geneva produced only broad guiding principles, with major details unresolved. The administration says diplomacy remains the first choice, but military action stays on the table as Iran fortifies key nuclear sites and regional allies warn of escalation in the coming days.



South Korean court hands life term to ex-President Yoon in insurrection trial

A Seoul court sentenced former South Korean President Yoon Suk Yeol to life imprisonment after convicting him of abusing authority and masterminding an insurrection tied to his December 2024 attempt to impose martial law. Prosecutors had sought the death penalty, though executions have not occurred since 1997. The court is also weighing allegations he ordered troops to storm parliament, detain opponents, and restrict access to political facilities; Yoon denies wrongdoing, saying he acted within presidential powers to warn against opposition obstruction. Detained at Seoul Detention Centre, Yoon is expected to appeal amid multiple pending cases as the country debates safeguards.
