Zelensky to the BBC: Putin has started World War Three and must be stopped.

Zelensky warned in an interview with the BBC that Putin has “started World War Three,” stressing that stopping him requires intense military and economic pressure. He rejected giving up territory or withdrawing from strategic positions in exchange for a ceasefire, saying this would weaken Ukraine and abandon its people. He insisted Ukraine will not lose, and that victory means preserving independence and stopping the fighting, while regaining all occupied territory in the long term when conditions allow. He also emphasized the need for long-term security guarantees before any elections.



Mexico's Army Special Forces led raid on Jalisco cartel

Mexico said Army Special Forces, supported by Air Force aircraft and the National Guard, led the Jalisco operation in which CJNG leader Nemesio “El Mencho” Oseguera Cervantes was fatally wounded after troops came under fire. Authorities said several cartel members were killed, wounded, or detained, and heavy weapons were seized. The raid underscores the military’s major role in Mexico’s domestic security operations. Reuters and AP also reported El Mencho’s death in the operation and described it as a major blow to the cartel, with fears of further violence afterward.



EU says it will accept no increase in US tariffs after Supreme Court ruling: 'a deal is a deal'

The European Commission asked Washington for full clarity after the U.S. Supreme Court struck down Trump’s global tariffs and he responded with new temporary tariffs of 10%, later raised to 15%. Brussels said this undermines the “fair, balanced, and mutually beneficial” trade framework agreed last year, stressing that “a deal is a deal.” The EU also warned the new tariffs could remove agreed exemptions, weaken the bloc’s competitive position, and create uncertainty for businesses and global markets.
