Russia questions how Trump's Board of Peace will work with UN Security Council

Russia said it is unclear how President Donald Trump's new "Board of Peace" would coexist with the U.N. Security Council, the only recognised body for maintaining peace and security. A Russian foreign ministry official told TASS the board's charter portrays it as replacing "ineffective" mechanisms, does not mention Gaza, and has not invited U.N. Secretary-General Antonio Guterres. The United States is the only permanent Security Council member to join. Trump chairs it with wide powers, including veto and member removals.

Iceland to hold EU referendum 'in the coming months', PM says

Iceland will hold a referendum in the coming months on whether to reopen European Union accession negotiations, Prime Minister Kristrun Frostadottir said in Warsaw. Iceland halted membership talks in 2013 after four years, but rising living costs and Russia's war in Ukraine have renewed interest in joining, polls show. U.S. President Donald Trump's repeated threats to annex Greenland have also raised the issue's urgency. Iceland already participates in the EU single market, Schengen, and EFTA, and is a NATO member.

How China is masking drone flights in potential Taiwan rehearsal

China has flown a large military drone over the South China Sea while broadcasting false transponder identities, making it appear to be other aircraft, Reuters reports. Since August, at least 23 flights used the call sign YILO4200 but transmitted registrations linked to planes such as a Belarusian cargo aircraft and a British Typhoon fighter. Analysts and diplomats say the pattern reflects more sophisticated "grey-zone" tactics, testing deception and decoy capabilities that could create confusion, mask surveillance, and rehearse routes relevant to a potential Taiwan operation.
